



Community Support Services (CSS), a leader in behavioral healthcare for adults living with severe and persistent mental illnesses is in search of a **Forensic Assertive Community Rehabilitation Specialist** to provide on-going community psychiatric support treatment services for a select group of clients who have been identified by the courts as individuals with a serious and persistent mental illness and in need of intensive rehabilitation services in the community.

Essential Functions:

1. Collaborates with the client to develop treatment plans that shall include services and assistance necessary to achieve recovery goals, including an explanation of the availability, intensity, and duration of each service.
2. Implements programming according to the treatment plan.
3. Makes observations and documents progress in accordance with established agency procedures.
4. Assists/trains clients in daily living skills such as laundry, household maintenance, cooking, communication and social skills, recreation, grocery shopping, personal hygiene, and self-care skills.
5. Monitors medication adherence in accordance with agency procedures to ensure that medications are taken as prescribed.
6. Assists clients in the proper budgeting and use of their funds.
7. Provide weekend and holiday coverage on a rotating basis.
8. Assists in crisis resolution using the least restrictive intervention.
9. Files unusual incident reports in appropriate occasions as indicated in policies and procedures.
10. Meets regularly with team members to plan interventions and share information relative to clients and their community adjustment.
11. Assists clients in obtaining transportation as needed.
12. Meets agency and ACT standards for frequency, duration and percentage of contact time spent in the community with clients.
13. Attends in-service and orientation program sessions as required.
14. Completes monthly reports to the court for all clients in the required time frame.
15. Keeps the court apprised of any changes in the client's status.

Employment Qualifications:

Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in a Human Services field required.

Direct service experience working in a similar position serving clients with a severe and persistent mental illness.

Experience working with or in coordination with the criminal justice system preferred.

Possession of a valid Ohio driver's license and insurability through Agency's insurance carrier required.
