- HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE WINTER CRISIS PROGRAM (HEAP) The provides an annual one-time benefit to eligible Ohio residents for help heating assistance during the fall and winter months. The benefit is applied directly to the utility to bill to help offset utility costs. The program runs from Nov. 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025, or until funds are depleted, whichever comes first. To apply, residents must schedule an appointment with Community Action by calling 330-436-0261 or scheduling online at app.capappointments.com.
